**Description-**

We will use our TSSA to increase and strengthen our Multi-Tier System of Supports framework. This program institutes interventions that provide increasingly intensive interventions for students at risk for or experiencing difficulties, including:

-Home visits

-Contracts and Academic small group intervention.

-Work with Roots KID program to create intervention systems, both academic and attendance-based. We have found a high correlation between attendance and pass rate.

We will use these funds to continue to support the Academic Rescue/Chasers Team. This program comprises two full-time positions.

This year, we implemented a caseload model for each grade, assigning it to a separate team.

**Budget Narrative-**

We will use these funds to maintain the two academic advisors.

These positions are unique to our program and have successfully supported our students who are low-achieving. We will use these funds to retain these positions.
